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#### 1. The healing of a blind man

the end! So also be You, Lord Jesus, in this morning hour the beginning here - and the allgloriously leading to the end! Amen!"

Simon replied: "What do you know about my life and my actions? Ask all the bystanders here what I have offered them; were they not delighted and excited by my performances? Of course, I cannot make the blind see or heal the possessed. But I would have great desire to learn it from you!"

Philip, full of the Spirit, spoke earnestly: "Simon, and all of you! Hear calmly and with an open heart what I must say to you, since the Spirit of pure and unselfish Love urges me to do so! There is not one among us who could say of himself: 'I have at all times fulfilled the commandments of God' and the will of the Lord Jehovah of hosts, and there is none who could testify: 'I can do without the grace of God!' All of us are guilty, and all of us are in need of His grace! But since the Lord sacrificed His life for us out of supreme love, a whole new way has been paved, which offers everyone the possibility of reaching where the goal of our longing lies. I am not sent to you to talk about your desires, but to show you the way to this new life, and to tell you whose Holy Spirit's children you can become, if you want to follow these ways.

You, Simon, were not a forerunner, because you endeavored to be a great one in everyone's eyes. You showed the way into the world, where lust and distraction entice, whereby you served a spirit, whose final goal is ruin and death. Now I have come, driven by the Spirit of God, and reveal the opposite to you. The way, which I show you, is called humility, devotion and renunciation and leads you to the height, to the inner perfection and to the eternal life with God! You have to choose now, since you have seen the consequences of a wrong action in your brother Jonah, and you were allowed to experience the power and the grace of Jesus, which brought him salvation. You should not only learn this message of peace, but experience for yourselves the grace and presence of Jesus! I am nothing, but Jesus is everything in everything! He wants to give us His spiritual life in the hope that we will then hand over our lower self to Him. Now choose the best of the best - your will is free!"

Philip was silent - and the crowd also remained in reverent silence. Simon did not dare to speak anymore, because the truth of all these words had been proven by the healing of Jonah.

So Asher's wife came before Philip and spoke aloud with a rare brightness in her eyes: "Men and women! Let me also speak about what is troubling me. My heart is so overflowing with joy, and I would perish in the dust if only I could do the great Savior any service. You all know about our years of misery. We bore it patiently in the hope that one day the hour would strike that would mean salvation, or that death would free us from all misery. But since yesterday, I have been taught otherwise. I now know what all suffering should serve us for. It is not proper for me to speak before men, but my inner experience is too important, therefore I want to confess before you what wonderful happiness has seized me!

You can easily imagine that I could not sleep for joy and gratitude until I learned that this healing is not true happiness at all, because misfortune could still befall us again. When I prayed, as Hannah once did, and directed all my thoughts to God, the holy Creator, a wonderful light came around me, and in a short time, also light in me! I looked around in

astonishment - our house has disappeared, my husband and my children have disappeared, as well as our dear, dear guest! I am frightened and feel so strange to myself, but a dear voice beside me says: "Do not be afraid, for behold, I know you and have found you worthy to receive what your heart has longed for. The end of your suffering is only there, when you can renounce every earthly desire, since I am the One who can replace everything for you.

Then I asked: Who are you? - and where are you? - and where am I? But the voice said in a much more sweet tone than before: "I am the Love that carries everything, and My life is the salvation of all the world! Look for Me in you, for only there am I to be found. I want to turn around, I want to see the speaker, the light fades away, but what remains is an inner joy, a joy such as I have never experienced before. And at that moment, Jesus stands before my eyes, as I knew Him, with His right hand pointing upward, but His left hand pointing toward the heart. I wanted to hold Him, but it was not possible, He disappeared, but the great joy remained! And in this joy, I only want to fulfill my duties more faithfully, because now I am only 'a handmaid of the Lord'.

When the woman was silent, Philip blessed the whole crowd once more and said, full of the Holy Spirit: "Bring, then, as in the Lord's lifetime, all your sick, that your outward affliction also may be bound up, and that you may arise in the all-quickening and all-satisfying Spirit of Jesus!"

After all had hurriedly brought their sick, and those who could not walk were gladly carried, an expectant silence took possession of all hearts.

Philip, praying aloud, invoked the presence of Jesus and glorified His indescribable love in His name! - In that holy moment, all were healed!

There was no end to the praise and glorification. The faith in the invisible presence of Jesus, was reaffirmed in the opened hearts. And even Simon the sorcerer humbly accepted this faith.

#### 3. Why does Jesus remain invisible to us?

The next day Philip sent Asher to Jerusalem to the apostles with the good news: In Samaria the gospel of Jesus Christ has been accepted! Philip had an easy job here, for the fame of his healings preceded him everywhere in the village and city and made hearts receptive; and everywhere the grace of God was visible. Hearts were opened to the joyful news: Jesus is alive and we can experience His presence! But it were specially consecrated hours when Philip baptized men and women in the name of Jesus Christ. A new life began throughout Samaria. Almsgiving and welfare were introduced as in the churches in Jerusalem, so that in the houses of the poor, there was no end to thanksgiving and praise. Philip often taught in Asher's house, and not a day passed without the grace and power of the Lord being vividly felt by those present.

The Samaritans experienced the climax when two disciples from Jerusalem, Peter and John, arrived with Asher in Sebaste and also took up residence in his poor hut. Peter, as the elder, preached with zeal of the Lord's words. John, however, only blessed.

Some priests, who disliked this enthusiasm, wanted to turn the people away again. To these the apostles of the Lord went into the synagogue, and many people followed them. Pleased, but also somewhat frightened by the large crowd of listeners, the priests nevertheless displayed great dignity and began their service. The text chosen was Isaiah 44:6-28 (the foolishness of idolatry). The priest Israel tried to say with eloquent words only what coincided with the law and the prophets. "For" - he continued - "no-one sees danger better than he who has himself been in danger. Therefore the Lord's request through Isaiah: keep away from everything new, from that which is likely to create idolatry. Even today, sorcerers are respected more than Jehovah and His servants, and greater honor is given to miracle-workers than to the Word of God and the place where His Holy Spirit is worshipped. Therefore, turn back and do not let yourselves be blinded by the new truth, which is not truth at all!"

The listeners became restless, anxiously they looked at Philip and his companions. But they remained calm and waited to see what would happen. When the priest was silent, he blessed the congregation and was about to step back, but Jonah, the one who had been healed, came up to him and asked aloud, "Israel! Your sermon was good, but it made me uneasy, for you call Him a 'miracle worker' who delivered me from the devils? How often did you yourself try your power on me when I was still in misery, but you always left me helpless and at a loss. Look, a single plea to Jesus the crucified and risen One, from the mouth of this man was enough, and I was delivered! You must not have understood my misery deeply enough and must feel little joy in my rescue and salvation, otherwise you would have had to speak differently today. Must only your insight and your will be decisive, and all others must not want anything else than you? Look at these three, they have no will of their own anymore! The will of their Lord and Savior Jesus has become their will. You priests, go into the huts of those who patiently endured sickness and hardship, but today are healthy and full of joy! Be convinced, they praise not Philip, the bringer of salvation and joy, but Jesus, the Anointed and Holy One of God!"

The priest was astonished to hear Jonah speak in this way, so he answered loudly: "Jonah, listen! You are the first to say such words to me with a bold spirit, therefore you shall also be the first to whom I say: If everything is true as you say, then I will repent in sackcloth and ashes and also confess Jesus of Nazareth! Nobody shall say that the old Israel has ever been a hindrance to his fellow men for the bodily or spiritual well-being. As a sign of my solidarity with you, Philip or someone else may now speak to all of us." Now the way was paved for Peter and John, and Peter began to speak: "Men! Dear brothers! The love and grace of God be with you! May the Spirit of peace be your portion, because it is a portion of Jesus Christ our Lord, Whose witnesses we here, are! Witnesses of His life, activity and work, but also witnesses of His death and resurrection! It is right, if you hold fast to the Word of the only true God and Lord and want to give glory only to Him! For that is exactly why we are here, to testify that Jesus wanted and taught nothing else.

God from eternity to eternity, the Creator and Sustainer of all things, saw His creations in danger, because the spirit of destruction, the enemy of all life, tried to fill not only all senses but also the hearts of the people with his godless nature. From Adam on, and ever since, God has been fighting the battle against His adversary. But this fight is only a protection of His holy goods of grace, because God never wanted to destroy His enemy!

God became a man, and gave the enemy of all existence and life again the proof that the preservation of all things is the basic principle of His nature! With the death of the Lord on the cross, His Spirit of eternal serving Love revealed itself to us even more. We, His witnesses, saw His glory in His resurrection from death, and still today experience His presence and the streams of power and life from His Spirit! May His enemies rage and with fire and sword try to eradicate His Spirit of serving love in the hearts of His followers, they will not succeed! Because Jesus – lives!

Examine this with open eyes and keep the peace in your hearts, which the love of Jesus gives to all who act fearlessly and faithfully according to His will! And so may the grace of the Lord be your portion in all things! Amen!"

Now John stepped forward, blessed those gathered and spoke: "The caring love for your souls does not allow me to remain silent - for I, too - by the immeasurable grace of the Lord - have been made worthy to be a disciple and witness of His power and glory. It is not necessary to speak much about His signs and wonders, since there are still enough eye-witnesses of them. But I am urged by the Spirit to speak of His love and His service to the human race, which is the most glorious gift of grace and intended for all who want to follow His footsteps. Jesus Christ, the Light and Salvation of all the world, has called not only us, but all to be bearers of this His Spirit. For only then can we recognize in all fullness: Who and what Jesus was - and will remain forever!

You know much about Him, but to recognize His essence and to understand Him in such a way that you want to give up all the old concepts rooted in your soul for the new light from His love, is still beyond you. Your misery and distress did not pass His heart without a trace; that is why He came to you, as to so many others, and extended His hand to you in holy union and wants to be your Helper and Deliverer. His whole endeavor was to reveal in the service of humanity, the Spirit that was lost to it. It is the Spirit of love, which has His original home in all heavens, and is the driving force that cannot rest or stop until all and everything created is filled with Him. Thus the kingdom of God is the infinite space where His holy will is the eternally sustaining and the perfection-striving principle.

Especially this earth with all it's inhabitants is called for His kingdom and was raised as a place of grace and school of education for them. Do not think: Why do we learn this only today? Know that this mission and high destiny was already revealed to the first man. The Lord has now tremendously shortened the long way, which was conditioned by the keeping of the Divine commandments, and showed us through His love, the new, shortest way to this our destiny.

'I give you a new commandment: that you love one another as I love you' - were His words, heavy with content. And therein lies the key for all of us to enter the eternal, glorious Kingdom of God. Love one another! - and you will be loved back! Love one another! - and heaven will be opened to you! Love one another! Then you will build a dwelling place on this earth for the Spirit of all life from God. In this love, hatred and envy disappear, suffering and affliction become the preliminary stages of inner enlightenment. The antagonisms between people, nations and churches cease, and we let God again wisely guide all our destinies.

Only this love will be able to transform every human being inwardly in such a way that he will only want to do what this love, as his innermost life, will urge him to do. So give this love room in your breast, so that His Spirit becomes the creating and redeeming principle in you! And so you, Jonah, come and receive through me the Spirit, which is holy, more than holy, and work from it according to God's holy will! Everything will be possible for you, if you really believe, but always remain grateful in humility and devotion to your God, who approaches you in Jesus Christ today! Now you need never fear any enemy, for God is strength and power and glory forever and ever! Amen."

Jonah knelt down, and John laid his hands on his head at these words. Then Jonas arose, and looking around him with radiant eyes he said: "Oh God! - Oh Father! - I am transformed! What delight do You cause in me! What happiness is in me! But for this I give thanks not to you alone, dear John, but to the holy God in Jesus Christ."

"Let your whole life be one of thanksgiving" - said John - "and let no sacrifice be too great for your love! For in your love you shall testify unto your brothers Jesus crucified and risen. Behold, this Spirit, who has been given to you as a gift of grace, shall now be your guide and lamp. He will renew your whole inner life and existence, so that you can now testify like a new man to the great goods of grace that you will now find within you. So be blessed out of this Spirit and become a blessing for others.

But you, Israel, who are a priest in this place, you too are called to work out of this Spirit! Life will beget life again, and love is always looking for opportunities where it can prove itself as love, and to witness that this is our service to our human brothers. Do not be afraid of becoming unfaithful to your God, for you will realize that in this Spirit, which is life and love, you are a thousand times closer to God than if you keep to your statutes and dead letters. The time has come when every cover will be taken away, when only the core - or the Spirit - as the innermost and truest life in the word, will serve you as a guide. You have seen what is possible to him who believes, and have experienced the stream of fire from the power of the Spirit out of God. And so I call out to you a word from the mouth of the Savior Jesus: Only he who does so, will realize that these are not words of man, but of God!

But you, Asher and Eva, arrange your house, we want to take the meal with you! But believe firmly that Eternal Love already knows all your worries and your desires!"

The synagogue emptied, but on the road a procession of people met them, accompanied by wagons drawn by beasts of burden. Peter went to meet them and was immediately recognized. How the arrivals rejoiced when Joseph, their elder, greeted Peter: "Praise be to Jesus Christ!" - and Peter gave thanks, saying: "His holy peace be with you!"

Joseph held Peter's hand tightly as he said, "Thank God we found you! All Samaria is full of wondrous talk about what is said to have happened here in Sebaste. My brothers are longing for help and truth, for the Lord's fate has a paralyzing effect on all of us. We know about His death and resurrection, but we can no longer bear the uncertainty: What will happen now? Our sick have no more hope, and all confidence is gone. For them, the Savior is dead! But the news of the healing of the possessed man and the healing of the blind man has again raised new hopes, and that is why we hurried here and found you."

"Your doubts shall be destroyed, and your faith shall be restored" - Peter answered - "but you must be able to believe that it is not we who can help, but only the Lord and Master! But if you still seek help from people, you will experience great disappointment. What has happened here in these days, is not the power of miracles, but the result of the power of faith. But it is not a good sign that you could doubt the words of the Master, because any doubt is a betrayal of your love for Him. Therefore, brother Joseph, see to it that the group entrusted to you gets back into the right inner order. For now, lead them all to the inn, but you come to us, we will stay with the healed Asher!"

This was done; the whole company could be accommodated in an inn, and all the sick on the wagons were also well taken care of.

In the dwelling of Asher a crowd gathered, because many did not want to separate from the apostles; but John, all love, spoke: "Brothers and sisters, listen: it is enough for today! Therefore, seek out your homes and join with us in spirit, so that a stream of power and blessing may fill our outer sphere of life! Remember, where there is a heaven, there is also a hell, and where there was a sowing for eternity, the enemy of all life also seeks to throw weeds into it. Your hearts must become quieter so that you can understand the greatness of these holy miracles of love and become more receptive to experiencing even greater miracles. But the greatest and most glorious miracle is to experience His holy Word in ourselves, which has all abilities to make us blessed and happy!

Make His Word your own, for it has eternal value! Tomorrow we will come to the inn where your brothers have lodged, and I invite you to there, because there it shall be revealed to all how the Lord and Master redeems His Word!"

It quieted down, but not all went, for the longing for pure truth was great in them! Soon the meal was laid out: bread, wine, honey and fruit, and how astonished was Eva to find all this in her food pantry, where for years there had been almost nothing! But in her heart it sounded like silver: "See, I am not only love, but also power! Therefore rejoice, that I may also rejoice over you!"

How quickly and joyfully she wanted to satisfy all the guests; but she carried a quiet sorrow in her that no-one asked where all the goods came from?

Peter blessed everyone and then the meal, and everyone took it with joy. Soon old Joseph, the leader of the caravan, arrived, and Asher led him to the three messengers of God, who blessed him and gave him bread and wine.

Joseph spoke with emotion: "Friends and brothers! I feel as if the Master Himself blessed me and gave me bread and wine to strengthen me! Therefore I will not give thanks to you, but only to the Lord and Master Jesus."

"Do this, brother Joseph!" - answered John - "for we seek no thanksgiving, but hearts that can give thanks from the depths of their souls to the great Giver of all gifts! Then we feel one with them, and in this oneness, new powers are released again. Common prayer and thanksgiving makes every heart freer! We can feel like children who only want to fulfill the will of their holy Father."

So Joseph asked: "Brother, tell us why Jesus, the Living and Risen One, could not stay here on our earth? It would be for all people the greatest conceivable proof of His Divinity and His mission, if He were to associate with His human children everywhere in all His glory and in the indestructible body. How soon all evil would have to give way and make room for the holy truth."

John answered: "Brother Joseph! In your question there is still much ignorance about the true nature and life of Jesus. You start from your human and intellectual concepts, and these hinder the pure and true knowledge in you. Above all, be assured that the Lord, according to His holy words, is always and all days present with us until the end of the world! He will never leave His own! Only personally and physically He had to remove Himself from us, and thus from all people, in order to give us and all human beings the possibility to work out of their freest love, and to do according to His holy will. Man, who by nature is predisposed to inertia, is thereby compelled to enter into right activity, so that he can experience the great, purest joy of shaping many things differently and anew in a creative way. The Master, as a perfected man, not only showed us His ability, but He let us experience the great, mighty overcoming of all evils, through which He united Himself with God and everything became possible for Him!

The whole of mankind has arrived at the lowest point, and their eternal lot would be misery, death and destruction. But the Lord had mercy on them and by His exemplary earthly life, created ways and means so that everyone could escape the evil! His mission as man was finished, and with His sacrifice, He sealed the new covenant He made with all people! His overcoming-Spirit is now His legacy to all, who with honest good will have His goal in mind, and this is called: To become one - with Jesus! If you, as well as all others, would be influenced by His constant personal presence to fulfill His will, you would be deprived of the most glorious thing, namely of the freedom of your will and action and thus of being child of God as His eternal inheritance. You would be His servant and receive the reward for your service, but you would always have to be aware that this state and service of yours could also come to an end one day.

But if you want to cooperate in the great work of Jesus out of your own free decision, and do not ask for reward or for His visible personal presence, you take His life or His Spirit into yourself and become His child. As His child, you are the bearer and realizer of His great thoughts, and with the whole strength of your love for Jesus, you also seek to realize what rests in you as an idea and ideal. Your longing, however, is still like closed gates that will only open when you become active in His glorious Spirit. But to be allowed to be active in His Spirit, is the greatest grace and holds the only true happiness! And only for the sake of our eternal happiness and salvation, Jesus could not remain with us in human form!"

Joseph was silent, but these words worked powerfully on him and the others. And so that day was ended.

#### 4. The chamberlain's longing for the true God

When all had gone to rest, an angel visibly came to Philip and showed him new tasks for his work. Astonished that the Lord did not himself give him the assignment in his heart, Philip asked: "Dear messenger of God, how is it that the Lord - your and my God - shows you my tasks to be done, since it is my greatest delight when I hear the Lord and Master Himself within me?"

"My brother!" - the angel answered - "Behold, we too have a longing to serve the Lord in many things, and blessed is it for us, if we can connect with you earth-dwellers. We look for such opportunities and ask the Lord and holy God for them, and gladly He grants us such requests. You are astonished because you, as a human being, in your naturalness cannot yet quite grasp our nature; but when we come to you, our service is not to you, but to the nascent life of God in your bosom. You are still kept in darkness about all the spiritual effects which this sanctified God-life produces; but rejoice, if you too may now experience and learn how you are supported by many forces in your inner love- and truth-life out of God!

The spiritual night has fallen upon the earth and is hammering with it's silent forces at the gates of light. It's demand is light. But it is reserved for the light to open the gates, to shine into the darkness, so that everything may be illuminated, and everyone may recognize in the light the great, holy truth about God and the holy meaning in all the forms of life.

So now, brother, according to the will of the Lord, go toward noon (south) to the road that leads from Jerusalem to Gaza, where it is desolate and empty all around. But take one more thing into your consciousness: That the whole heaven bends before the awakening life out of Christ in your breast, and you give in this existence and life the formation of a new heaven, in which the Lord and eternal God wants to take residence as now your Father! Therefore I evaluate my service rendered to you, as if I had served God Himself with it. The peace of God be with you!" - and Philip was alone.

Immediately he got ready and went straight towards noon, towards his goal shown by the angel. Glad in heart, and without asking much about the task waiting for him, he wandered with only short rests through the night and morning hours and finally arrived in a sandy desert region, which could well be his destination. Here Philip saw from afar a small chariot in which a man was sitting, and the Spirit within him alerted him to his mission, saying: "Go and stand by this chariot."

Without much thought, he walked toward the vehicle and heard the man reading aloud in the prophet Isaiah (Acts 8:26).

Philip greeted him and asked: "Do you also understand what you are reading?"

"How can I understand it when no-one has yet taught me and given me the knowledge necessary to understand your writings! I came to Jerusalem to worship the only true God in your temple, and they gave me these scriptures! Will you get up and give me the necessary guidance? I am Themann, the confidant and counselor of my queen Kandaze in Moorland, and who knows when I will ever come to Jerusalem again!"

So Philip sat down with him in the little chariot, took the Scripture from his hand, and read aloud the following passage in the 53rd chapter, verses 7 and 8: "When He was

maltreated, He bowed down, and opened not His mouth, as a sheep led to the slaughter, and as a lamb that before it's shearer is silence, and opens not its mouth. From imprisonment and judgment He was led away. But who considered in His day that He would be torn away from the land of the living and be struck to death by the iniquity of His people?"

Themann looked at Philip and said: "I ask you to explain to me the meaning of these words! Of whom does your prophet speak such things? It is difficult to understand anything from your sacred traditions."

Then Philip answered: "This is only your own opinion, since our God is still something foreign to you! If you knew this our great God, you would also understand His Word, for in the Word, He is near to us all! His holy Word gives us promises of a Savior from all evils. And of this we have just read in Isaiah. You have heard of the great events in the whole Jewish land and the greatest of all at the Passover feast in Jerusalem? Here the prophet Isaiah already points to this future Redeemer, to Jesus and His crucifixion! He was called by the great redemption plan of God to prepare a way for all of mankind, on which they can return to the only true life of God, easier than through laws.

Only a few recognized in Jesus of Nazareth the fulfillment of all these promises and the great glory of His inner Being. From the earliest youth, He knew: Great things can only be solved by a great spirit, by a Spirit which this earth has not yet known! Thus all in Judea and Samaria were richly blessed by this Son of Man, Jesus of Nazareth. It was not enough that many a miracle and many a deed of love stirred up the hearts and made them beat faster when it was said: Jesus of Nazareth is coming! Much, much more powerful than His deeds were His words. Words of the inner life! Words - from the life of God! All the old concepts in us became like new. New hopes and new life created new people, people who now experienced in Jesus their inner support and their eternal salvation. Thus a new Spirit was given to the earth, and this Spirit was the Life, the love and the Being of Jesus!"

Thinking, Themann spoke: "Dear friend! But I still cannot understand how you want to connect this Jesus with the present scriptural passages? You told many great and amazing things about your Jesus, but these words here indicate much sadness and a quiet humility; and that He fell victim to the malice of His enemies."

Philip replied: "I am not yet quite finished with my testimony of the Great and Glorious One, who in His boundless love became the Mediator between the Holy God and us sinful men. Behold, the world is seduced to the core by a spirit that wants to destroy God and His works. It has come to such a point that this enemy of all peaceful life lives under the delusion that he is the Lord. Yes, there is no human being living on this earth who has not already become a victim of this destructive spirit! Still a short time, and the whole world would stand before it's own destruction, from which there would be no more redemption.

But this man Jesus not only saw these dangers and the consequences. He banished them and put His own life, His whole will and ability in the place where the enemy of all life wanted to erect a throne for spiritual death. His life full of purity and exceeding love and faithfulness, is the eternal support on which every sin and it's consequences must be shattered! He made Himself the vessel, took upon Himself all our guilt and iniquity, and bore in His body all the curse on the cross! If Jesus had only fulfilled the will of God, His holy mission would have been accomplished, but without the great value for the coming generations. He had to add something of Himself, and this, as the greatest, people almost never consider. Above all, He had to forget who He was, had to live in His human self, had to seek out that distant God of lost mankind in His own inner world, by finding Himself again completely as a natural man.

From this state He had to pay back every tribute to the earth, His flesh and His I by overcoming all human weaknesses and temptations. Now, as a Lord and Commander above the earthly processes and above all natural forces, He, as the Son of Man, always remained simple and helpful to all the poor, and thereby visibly lived this God-life risen in Him for all of us. How highly the people of this earth were esteemed by Jesus cannot be expressed in words, for He, the Great and Glorious One, laid His life on the line for the salvation of the lost. He took up the fight with the enemy of life and was apparently defeated. But - after three days the whole of infinity had to experience that Jesus, as the Lord, also became the victor over all death and could loudly exclaim: "I - live! And through Me, all will live who believe in Me and want to follow Me! One must have experienced this triumph, must have been in all stages of deepest suffering to understand: Jesus was the victor! Jesus is now finally the Lord to whom all powers must bow! His dominion, however, is like a balm for all sore hearts, is a call and an invitation to enjoy with Him those great spiritual goods of grace which He provides in His endless love for all who have gone astray!"

Themann remained the right hand of his mistress. He himself knew only the one advisor, Jesus, who appeared to him in the desert. He communicated with Him daily, and in his love for Him, he also found new tasks and duties every day, so that he soon became an indispensable teacher and friend to his queen as well as to his fellow men.

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
